Are you being bullied?

- 📣 Do you know that a threat is considered an act of bullying?
- 📣 Do you know that teasing can be a form of bullying?
- 📣 Do you feel put down or picked on?
- 📣 Do you know that under Georgia law bullying is prohibited by school policy?
- 📣 Do you know that your teachers and parents may not realize you are being bullied unless you tell them?
- 📣 Do you know that you are not alone and that there is somewhere to turn?
- 📣 The effects of bullying can follow a person into adulthood in the form of low self-esteem, depression, anxiety, addiction, negative body image and relationship problems.

Know the Laws Against

BULLYING

Per OCGA 20-2-751.4

- ⚡ Bullying is not allowed at any school in Georgia.
- ⚡ A bully is someone who tries to hurt, embarrass, or threaten you physically or verbally.
- ⚡ A bully is someone who makes you fear for your safety.
- ⚡ Bullying is not just a boy's issue. Girls are more likely to use hurtful or untrue gossip and rejection when they bully.
- ⚡ Bullying is taken seriously by teachers, schools, parents, and law enforcement officials.
- ⚡ If you or someone you know has a problem with any form of bullying, talk to someone who cares by calling **211** (metro Atlanta or other metro areas) or call Prevent Child Abuse Georgia's **Helpline**, open 8AM til 8PM Monday through Friday.
